

OLD MISSION MONTESSORI SCHOOL EARTHQUAKE AND DISASTER PROVISIONS

Dear Parents,

Old Mission Montessori School is aware and sensitive of the need to be prepared in the case of an emergency. We will be educating the children on what to do in the case of a fire or earthquake. We will be holding fire and earthquake drills on a regular basis.

The school has flashlights, first aid equipment, and water on hand for all the children. We need your assistance by providing personal items for your children. We are asking each child to bring in personal provisions of non-perishable food and drink that would cover his/her personal needs for the period of time they may be detained at the school. The following is a suggested list of the type of food you may choose to consider in your child's kit.

Bottle water

Two 4 ½ oz. cans of fruit or pudding

Three 6 or 8 oz. box drinks

Two 3 ½ oz. cans of tuna, chicken, etc. (with pop top)

Two packages of crackers

Two fruit rolls/fruit snack

Two lollipops

Two granola bars

Two plastic spoons and forks

These are only suggestions. However, it is necessary that the food items that are supplied for your child fit in a one gallon size zip-lock bag (nothing larger can be accepted). Please label the zip-lock bag with your child's name. It is important that the food items are things your child will be willing to eat and that they be items that can be stored without refrigeration.

In addition to these items we ask that each family bring the following items for each of their children: **1 large size beach towel, letter from parents to child and picture of family.**
